PRESIDENT'S CORNER JULY 2003

Don't forget this coming Sunday July 27th, starting at nine AM, we will have a fun fly and a steak fry. If you are planning to enter the contest please arrive early. We also need a few volunteers to help manage the event and help with the food.

This contest will challenge your flying skills and compare them to other pilots as well. That is always a big help in improving how well you do.

We have designed the contest to be something everyone can do, so don't be afraid to enter, even if you're relatively new to the sport.

The entry fee is only \$5.00 and we promise you will have a lot of fun.

The events will be as follows

- (1) Loop Contest- This will be the number of loops in one minute.
- (2) Bomb Drop- We will attach a bomb dropping apparatus to your airplane, you will then try to hit a target.
- (3) Dead Stick spot Landing- In this case you fly past a certain point, then kill your engine, you must circle around and land as close to the target as possible.
- (4) Two Man Crap Shoot- This event will combine a short pylon race with a roll of the dice. You will roll the dice for your point, then we start the race and you must land and make your point.
- (5) Looney Limbo- a ribbon will be stretched across the runway ten feet high; you will score one point for each time you can



pass under the ribbon in one minute. So, as you can see, these events are challenging, but simple.

Plus we will be cooking some rib eye steaks as well as hamburgers, hot dogs and chicken. So bring your family.

On a more serious note, it has become apparent that as more and more pilots are flying on the weekends that we need to become more safety conscious. We have had some close calls and some arguments lately, and I think it is time to start enforce tighter rules. I know we all go down to the field to have fun and none of us want to confront people or have to become policemen, but, if we don't do it who will?

From now on I would like to see every member of the club step up when you see a rule being broken, don't wait for some one else to do it. Some times these people simply do not know what they are supposed to do, and all they need is a little talking to, usually you will make a new friend. 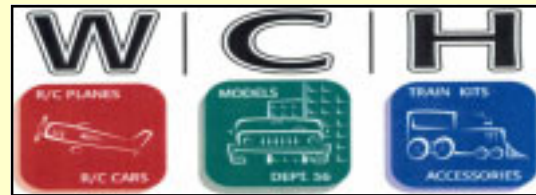
